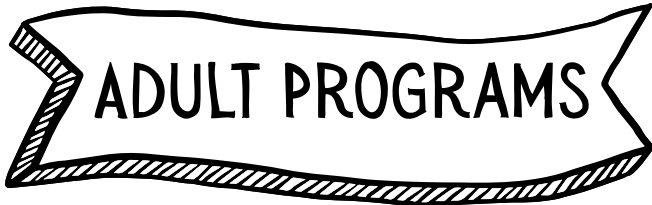

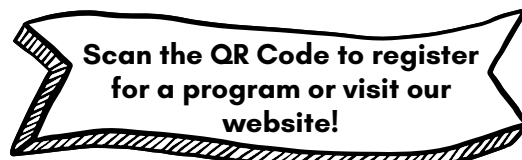


**Passport to CT

Giant Qwirkle! (ages 6+)

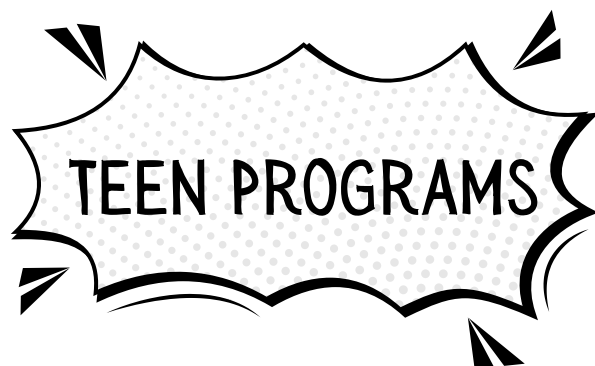
