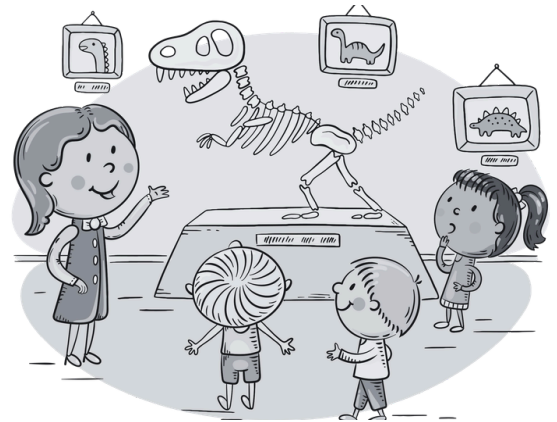

Transitions are often the hardest part of parenting, especially for children with autism, ADHD, or behavioral challenges. Join us for a free, 60-minute interactive workshop led by John Oliver, Clinical Director of Pack ABA. This session is designed to teach parents practical, positive-behavior strategies to handle the chaos of shifting schedules.

What Parents Will Learn:

- The "Why" Behind the Behavior: Understanding exactly why schedule changes and transitions are so difficult for children to process.
